# GLOBAL UPDATE

Dear GBCs, partners and sustainable building advocates,

Welcome to the WorldGBC April Global Update.

It's now or never – the [recent IPCC report](#) warns that current national pledges are not ambitious enough to stop global warming from exceeding 1.5°C. For the built environment, the report revealed promising data about our sector's potential to accelerate climate action through solutions that already exist. But *only* if we see an immediate increase in political ambition and financial incentives to make this happen at scale.

March has been an incredible month for the WorldGBC global network, as our Green Building Councils (GBCs) have been able to connect on a scale which we have not seen since the start of the pandemic.

Our Middle East and Africa Green Building Congress saw over 200 attendees from 43 countries and 67 networking meetings. And our European Regional Network brought #BuildingLife GBCs together in Rome, Italy, at our first in-person event for two years, creating a truly collaborative space to take forward our mission to decarbonise Europe's built environment.
