Welcome to the September Global Update!

Next week marks World Green Building Council's (WorldGBC) 15th annual [World Green Building Week](#). From 11–15 September, we're calling on the global building and construction sector to accelerate the transition to secure an energy efficient, regenerative and just future for all through [#BuildingTheTransition](#).

Led by a network of over 75 national Green Building Councils (GBCs) and their 46,000 members, the week-long campaign will show how through systems change thinking, and leveraging local solutions, we can transition to sustainable built environments.

September is a critical month for climate action. Firstly, today the UNFCCC is expected to publish the Global Stocktake synthesis report [on their website](#) demonstrating a comprehensive assessment of global action on climate change to date. This is the result of two years of consultations and inputs from governments, businesses and NGOs.

I am anticipating that the findings of this paper will be a call for us to double down our efforts – which is why we must ensure momentum for sustainability in the built environment snowballs ahead of COP28, in Dubai, UAE.

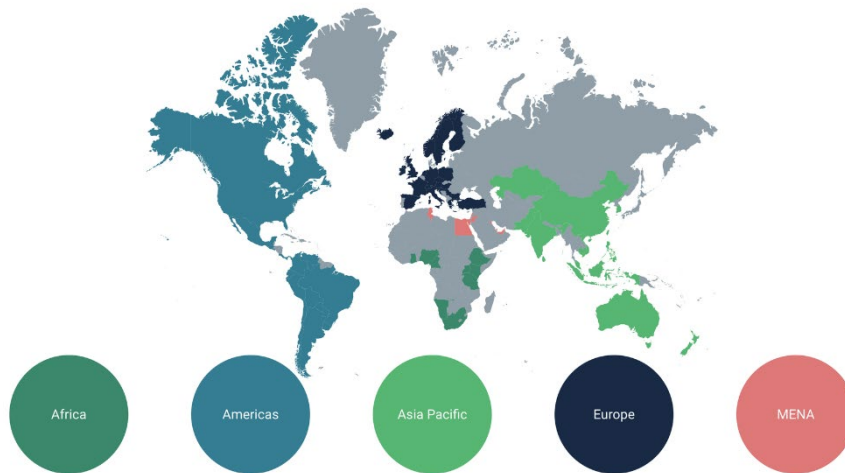
