This week world leaders arrive in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, for COP28.

This COP is a hugely significant opportunity for policymakers to deliver the future we know is possible and kickstart a decade of action to make the transition to a sustainable future a reality.

The good news is that the building and construction sector can mobilise and scale solutions *now* to deliver a future that is energy efficient, regenerative and just. WorldGBC, our [global network of 75+ Green Building Councils \(GBCs\)](#), and their network of more than 46,000 members can make the COP28 Action Agenda a reality. Not only can we, but we already are.

Our GBCs are supporting governments, businesses and the finance community through local green building solutions that already exist. [Together we're #BuildingTheTransition](#) for COP28 and beyond.

[Our network also welcomes the Buildings Breakthrough](#) initiative led by France and the Kingdom of Morocco as endorsed by 20+ countries. Two of WorldGBC's climate action programmes – [BuildingLife](#) and [Advancing Net Zero](#) – are recognised as key initiatives that support the delivery of the Breakthrough.

But the implementation of the Buildings Breakthrough needs to happen through local action on the ground – this is exactly what our GBCs are doing by mobilising their networks of +46,000 companies to deliver this impact and improve local and national policies.

We must ensure COP28 is *the* COP where we get the Global Stocktake on emissions right, increase ambition of Nationally Determined Contributions, and start building the transition to a sustainable future, together.

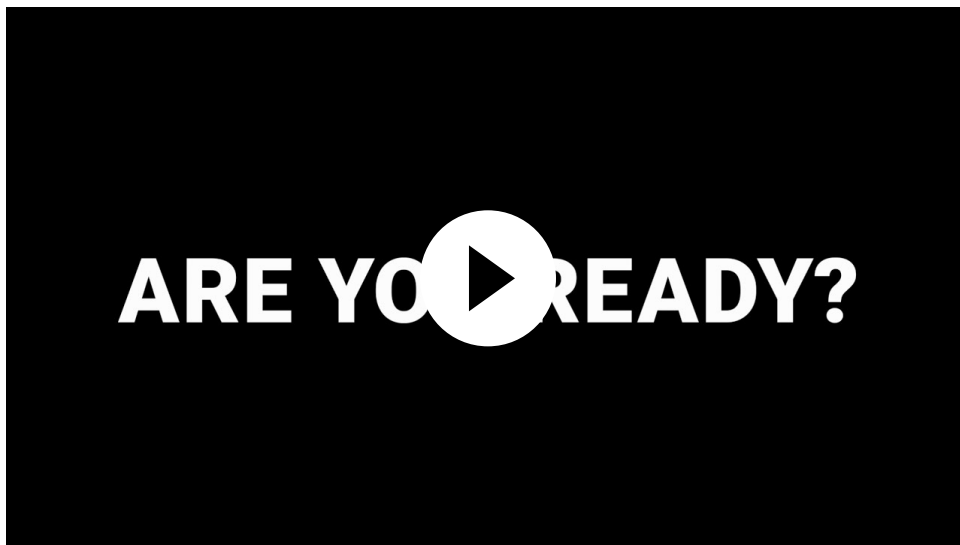

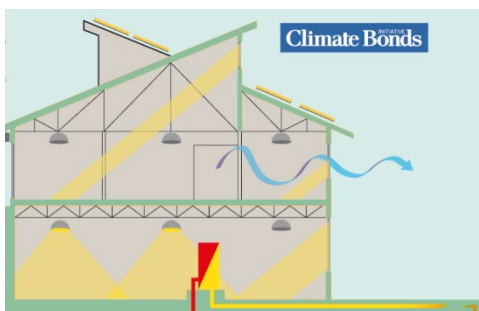

Upon completion, it is expected to be the tallest tower in Latin America at a height of 475 meters and 100 stories.

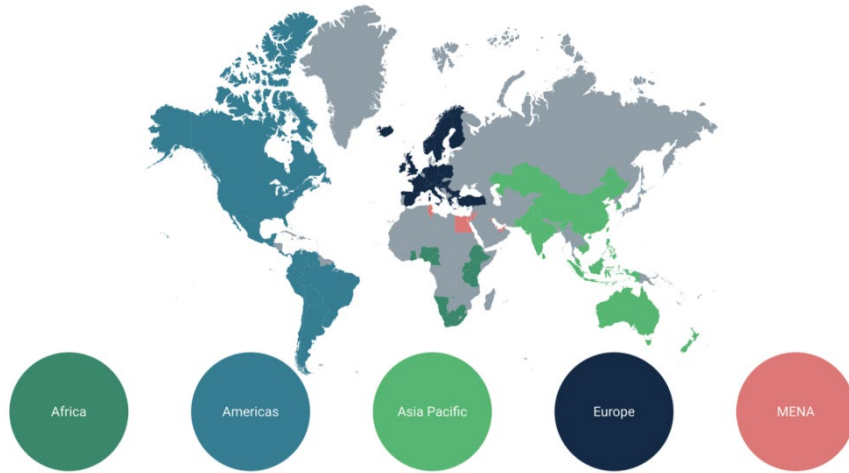


The United Arab Emirates government supports the net zero agenda
