Dear GBCs, partners and sustainable building advocates,

September was an incredible month, full of dynamic activity. Firstly, I want to thank all of you for taking part in our 15th annual [World Green Building Week](#) on 11–15 September 2023 featuring the COP28 High-Level Climate Champion, H.E. Razan Al Mubarak. Our network joined us in a unified call for #BuildingTheTransition and we saw Green Building Councils (GBCs) around the world take part, reaching millions.

Last month I also contributed to high-level events during Climate Week New York City, and joined in [USGBC's 30 Year celebrations](#). It is truly encouraging to experience first hand the rising recognition for buildings as a critical climate solution, as well as how much impact our movement has created so far, whilst also acknowledging the urgency to reach a scale that changes these current, unsustainable trajectories.

Last month the Global Stocktake (GST) synthesis report was published by UNFCCC and you can view our full response [here](#). We are very pleased to see the [Breakthrough Agenda 2023 Report](#), acknowledging the key role that buildings can play in delivering the systemic transformation needed for a sustainable and decarbonised future. A key moment for us was also the mobilisation of 41 key stakeholder groups and businesses in voicing support for the European Commission's development of a Whole Life Carbon Roadmap for the building sector. 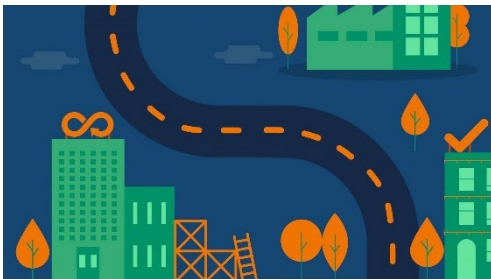


Celebrating World Green Building Week 2023

With a social media reach of 6.5 million, over 120 events being hosted around the world and 85% of GBCs participating, this was our biggest [#WGBW](#) campaign yet.

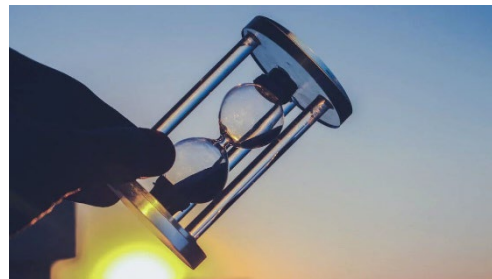

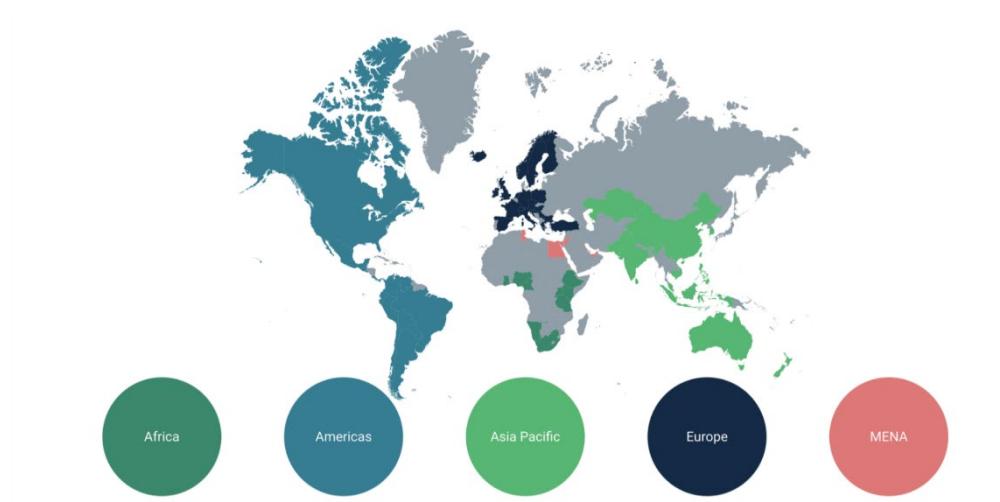
