At the [UN Climate Conference COP29](#) in Baku, Azerbaijan, the World Green Building Council (WorldGBC) represented the voice of our global network as we called on international governments and industry to [#BeBoldOnBuildings](#).

The headline announcement was the New Collective Quantified Goal on Climate Finance (NCQG). Whilst this deal remains insufficient to meet the needs of developing countries, it marks a step forward in recognising the scale of what's needed, and creates a foundation on which to build.


