We're calling on EU policymakers to take decisive action on the built environment

With the 2024 European Elections on the horizon, Europe faces a golden opportunity for politicians to implement more robust initiatives and incentives to secure sustainable buildings across the continent.

On 16 April 2024, WorldGBC launched the European Manifesto for a Sustainable Built Environment, featuring sustainable building policy recommendations. Developed by WorldGBC in collaboration with 24 European Green Building Councils and supported by seven regional partners, the manifesto sets out our vision for how sustainable buildings can be at the heart of a prosperous and equitable future for Europe.

In April, the European Parliament voted to approve an update to the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD), in a crucial step towards accelerating climate action on buildings. We are pleased that the new EPBD includes measures to drive the renovation of Europe's buildings and, for the first time, measures to address the Whole Life Carbon impact of buildings.

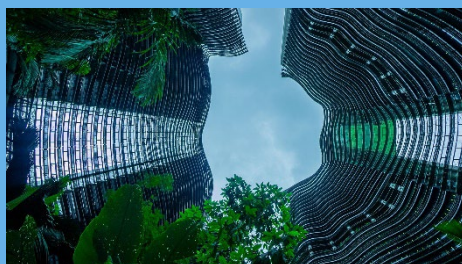

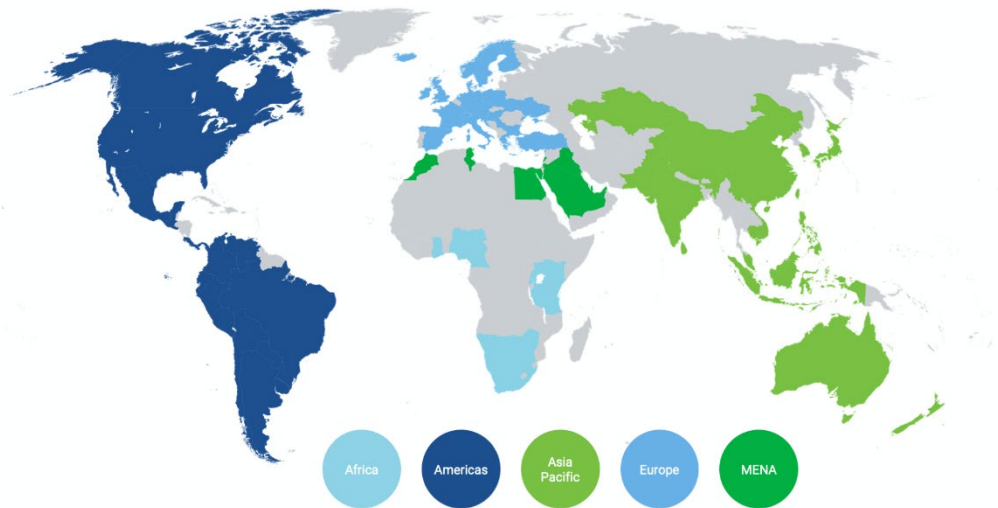
